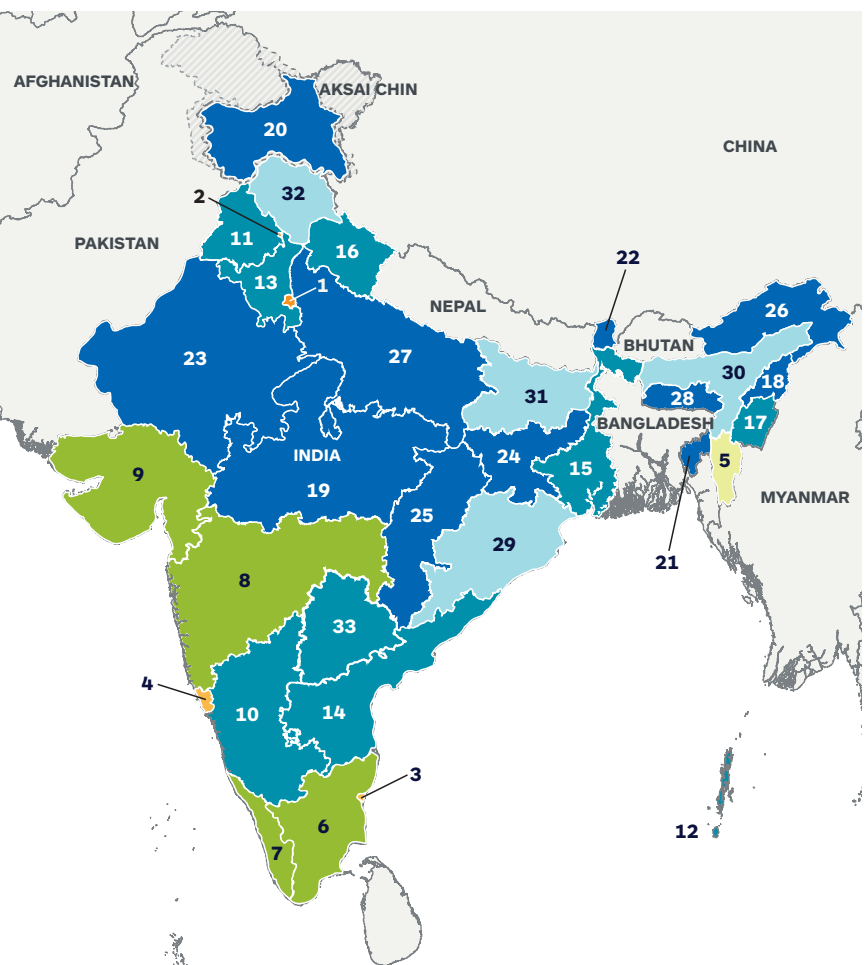


# Urbanization rates in India correlate directly to a state's potential for economic growth
