



Feature	Benefit
Sea-web Ships - Save Search	Ability to save and recall both simple and complex searches for improved workflows
Sea-web Ships - IMO upload	Provides notification on incorrect LR/IMO numbers uploaded in the list so users are alerted and can investigate further
Sea-web Ships - Fields to Display	Save, load and update fields to display saving time and effort when selecting key fields of interest and switching between data fields
Sea-web Ships - Coating Types	Ability added to search by coating types on chemical tankers (for example stainless steel tanks)
Sea-web Movements - New Fields to Display	More flexibility in the ship and ownership content that can be shown in the grid view with the movements and exported
Sea-web Movements - Port Calls	Estimated cargo field added to port callings information providing a view of cargo volumes on-board when arriving/departing a port (estimates are derived from AIS draught analysis)
Sea-web Movements - Search Interface	Simplified Movements Search screen with advanced options providing a simpler, quicker and easier search interface to use berth, terminal, port or country callings
Sea-web Movements - Port Name	Port Name added to search results allowing users to group results by the port

Feature	Benefit
AISLive - Ship Track	MMSI tracks by hours with optional display of track to destination
AISLive - Ship Track - Colours	Improved visibility of different ship tracks when looking at multiple ship tracks with the cycle track colour options
AISLive - Ship Track, Draught & Speed Values	The speed and draught track colors values are now entered by the user and never automatically changed so that the colouring is consistent regardless of the ship track(s) viewed
AISLive - Real Time Intelligence View	Destination Country (Top 10) added. Analyse ships displayed on map destined for top 10 Countries (based on AIS message), providing additional analysis view of ships in view
AISLive - Ship Filters	Now filter by TEU & Gas Capacity, assists users to identify container or gas carrying capabilities
AISLive - Miscellaneous Ship Type colours	Miscellaneous Ship type color display now matches major ship type (tankers, bulkers, etc.) colors - allowing identification of major ship types even if they are within a miscellaneous category (such as inland or non-ship shape)

Feature	Benefit
MIRS - Screening	Screening of beneficial owners of companies and BOs of BOs of owners, enables users to perform due diligence to the appropriate company structure levels
MIRS - Screening	Screen port calls for 180 Days, (US legislation) / Easy view for ships that are going into the US
MIRS - Zone Notifications	User can now edit or set up new notifications based on MIRS zones
AIS Data Quality	
Indicate invalid MMSI's	When a target is an invalid (outside of issued range) MMSI the shape of the ship changes to a grey diamond to flag to users that there is a possible issue with the data
Incorrect AIS data	Removes non-valid MMSI targets on the map after one day as these are likely errant or non-ship messages to improve the quality of data visualized
Identify non-ship MMSI's	Invalid MMSIs identified in the real time intelligence calculations so users can understand how many there are
Filter out non-ship MMSI's	Enables users to filter invalid MMSI's so that they can see just those valid targets based MMSI
