


Are you prepared for the growth in global truck segments?

In 2017, China's medium & heavy truck sales rose 40% y/y and hit the historical highest level, and sales of artics (tractors) alone

surged more than 50%. Installation of natural-gas engines in heavy trucks nearly quadrupled and is predicted to further expand to 2020.

From 2018-30, production of medium & heavy trucks (>6T) 5%.



In North America, installations of natural-gas engines in heavy-duty (Class 8) trucks are predicted to nearly double as a share of the total between 2017 and 2020.

The trucking industry accounted for approximately One-fifth of global oil demand in 2017.

In 2021, global medium-duty (6-15T) truck sales will exceed 1.0 million **annually** for the first time in nearly a decade.

By 2025, about 95% of the world's medium-& heavy-truck sales volume is expected to meet the equivalent of Euro V or higher emissions standards, up from below 50% in 2015.
